WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP?

An apprenticeship allows you to get an accredited qualification while working and earning wages in the career of your choice.

Inside Wireman Apprenticeship: This is a 4-year program of study with its primary focus on Commercial and Industrial electrical construction. The apprenticeship program of study includes a minimum of 8,000 hours of on-the-job learning (5 levels of pay) as well as a minimum of 900 hours of related classroom and hands-on lab instruction. Students in this program attend related classroom and hands-on lab instruction classes one day every other week from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Completion of this program leads to Department of Labor Journey-Level Electrician Certification and Electrical Training Alliance Journey-Level Electrician Certification.


